1. Technical Expert

- Establish Policies and Best Practices on the use of technology at Beta Theta Pi
- o Lend expertise to internal departments and task forces as needed
- Identify emerging technologies to be added to or integrated with the existing infrastructure in support or the overall efforts and programs of the Fraternity

2. Systems Administrator

- Maintain the integrity and continual operation of the Beta Theta Pi network
- Ensure the continual functioning of mission critical applications
- Maintain security and privacy of the information systems, communication lines, and equipment

3. Data Manager

- Oversee the scheduling of database jobs/scripts, database and transaction log backups, notifications, and data synchronization/replication
- Create and optimize automation processes

- o Provide technical designs, reports, documentation, and other materials required by staff and vendors
- Create and maintain database reporting systems
- Maintain a test database environment

4. Help Desk
